



Bicycles

Bike hire is available through Suffolk Cycle Breaks (www.cyclebreaks.com) and they deliver to and collect from Secret Meadows. We have recommended cycle routes - please let us know if you would like us to e-mail a copy to you.

Footpaths

There are some lovely local footpaths around the farm including to the Turk's Head in the village (theturksheadhasketon.co.uk) and Boulge Church (known as the 'Church in the Fields'). Recommended walks are shown on maps in the welcome/info pack.

By Car

Below, we provide directions for the best route to White House Farm, taking into consideration the local residents and the single track roads.

CAR SHARE: If visiting with friends please consider car sharing when travelling to the site, and during your stay.

From the A12

1. Travelling north on the A12, shortly after the Sutton Hoo/Melton A12 roundabout just after Woodbridge, take the **first** left signposted to Bredfield.

OR: **Travelling south**, after the Wickham Market bypass A12 dual carriageway ends, take the **second** right signposted to Bredfield.

2. Then take the first left signposted to Hasketon.

3. Take the second right turning just after a barn conversion on the left hand side where the sign does not point to the right but says Hasketon and Woodbridge straight on and Bredfield and Dallinghoo towards the way you have come (If you pass Highfield House on the left, you have just missed the turning).

4. White House Farm is about 1/3 mile down this road on the right hand side after Fir Tree Cottages on the right then about 50 metres after Hasketon House and the red brick cart lodge on the right. When you turn into the driveway, you'll see an old cartshed in front of you. When you turn into the driveway, veer right (signed Secret Meadows) then turn left (signed Secret Meadows) where you will see a grass parking area and the pantry/wood store sheds.

From the A14 then A140 onto B1079 Grundisburgh Road

1. From the A14, turn off onto the A140.

2. At the roundabout, take first left onto A140 towards Norwich then take the first right turning which crosses the A140 onto the B1078 to Coddensham.

3. At Otley, you will drive past the entrance to Otley College and at the T-junction at the end of the road, turn right towards Woodbridge/Clopton B1079. Keep on this road passing Clopton, and the outskirts of Burgh and Grundisburgh. Keep on this road, round the sharp left hand bend at the Grundisburgh turning, and after about 1.5 miles you will pass Grange Farm Shop in Hasketon.

4. Take the second left turning after Grange Farm Shop into Hasketon village. This turning is on a sharp right hand bend. If you reach the roundabout at the A12 you have gone too far but you can turn back on this road at the roundabout and take the first right turning.

5. Then take the first left turning and you'll drive through Hasketon, passing the church on your left and the village hall and bus shelter on your right. After these you will come to a sharp right bend displaying a 'Boulge Road' sign on a low brick wall. **After** this sharp right-hand bend take the second left (this is just after Highfield House).

6. Follow point 4. under the A12 instructions above.

By Train: Woodbridge train station (regular direct trains available from London Liverpool Street then change at Ipswich to Woodbridge (taking the Ipswich to Lowestoft line). There are taxis at the train station: M & R Cars, tel. 01394 380034. It is best to book in advance as they can be busy. Alternatively, from the train station you can take a bus from a nearby bus stop on Hamblin Road (see below).

By bus from Woodbridge Train Station (takes approx. 13 mins) : Buses run several times a day Monday to Saturday (no bus service available on Sundays). From Woodbridge train station, walk (approx. 5 mins) to Hamblin Road opposite the Turban Centre, to the 64 bus stop (a map is provided on the website search results page). The 64 bus takes you to Hasketon Church. Walking from Hasketon Church bus stop to White House Farm (takes approx. 1/2 hour):

With Hasketon church on your left and the village hall/post box on your right, walk straight ahead. You will reach a sharp right hand bend where there is a brick wall with a Boulge Road sign. Follow the bend to the right and carry straight on. Turn down the second left turning, in about 1/2 mile, opposite Highfield House. White House Farm is a 1/3 mile down this road on the right hand side. You will pass Fir Tree Cottages then Hasketon House before you arrive at White House Farm on the right hand side.
